



Back By Popular Demand: Flood Insurance Training!

FEMA has mandated that all agents who sell flood insurance must attend a one-time 3- hour flood insurance training class. We held classes in 2006 and 2007, but have not offered classes the past two years. Many agents have asked, "Are you planning to hold another flood insurance training class?" The answer is "yes"!

Who should attend? All agents who have not yet received flood insurance training and all agents who would like to "brush up" on flood insurance. There have been changes in the flood program in the last few months.

Attendees will receive 3.0 hours of continuing education credit. **PLEASE NOTE:** These classes do not appear in the annual AIA Education Calendar. They were added after the calendar went to print.
