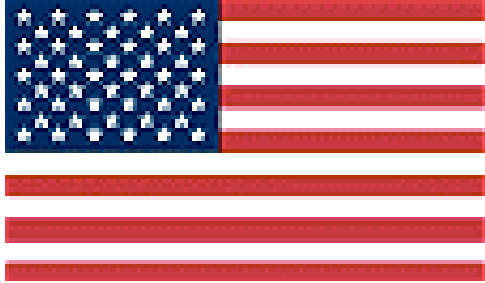


# AIIA and BIIA Donate \$10,000 to America's Survivor Relief Fund
